Sixth Form Uniform

Pupils should present a smart, businesslike appearance at all times. Jackets must be worn when moving around the School.

- Dark coloured plain or pinstripe business suit (trousers, a dress or a skirt with an appropriate length)
- Light coloured or white blouse/shirt - T shirts or fashion tops are not acceptable (white blouses/shirts to be worn on all formal School occasions, eg Speech Day, concerts etc).
- Tie (not featuring cartoon characters).
- A plain jumper is optional under jacket.
- Smart style shoes (heel height should be practical, no more than 5cm). Subtle/plain colours should be worn - No platforms.
- Make up and jewellery should be discreet.
