There will also be the opportunity to teach History at Key Stage 3. The successful candidate will be an excellent classroom teacher, with the ability to inspire and challenge all pupils to achieve their full potential.

Derby Grammar School is an all-through school from Reception to Sixth Form. Our Senior School (Years 7 to 11) is two form entry, with small class sizes and a family feel. We enjoy positive and constructive working relationships with our students. Geography is studied by all pupils in Years 7, 8 and 9 and by many pupils as an optional subject at GCSE, where the AQA specification is taught. At Key Stage 3, all pupils follow departmental schemes of work. Small numbers of pupils take Geography A Level, where we also offer the AQA specification.
